- 1.5 This humorous story is a South African reality. [50]

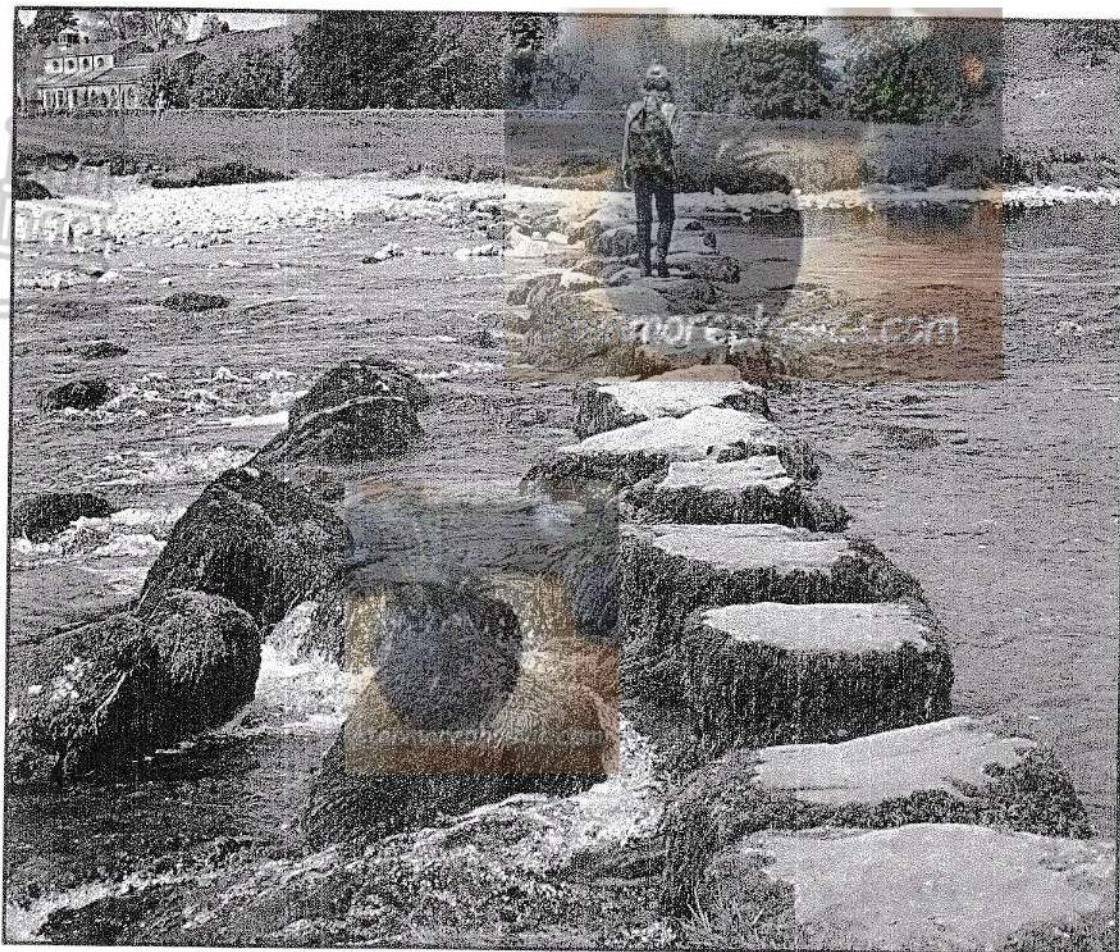
The pictures reproduced on pages 4 and 5 may evoke a reaction or feeling in you or stir your imagination.

NOTE: There must be a clear link between your essay and the picture you have chosen.



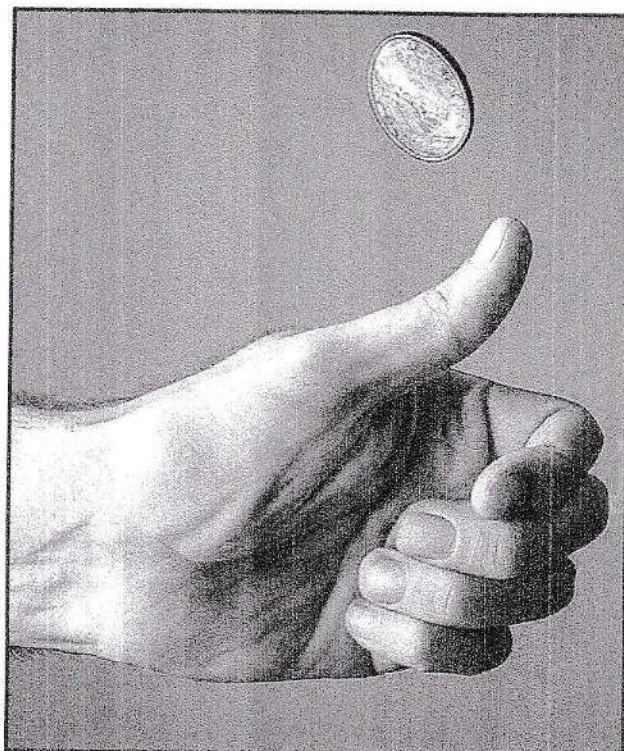



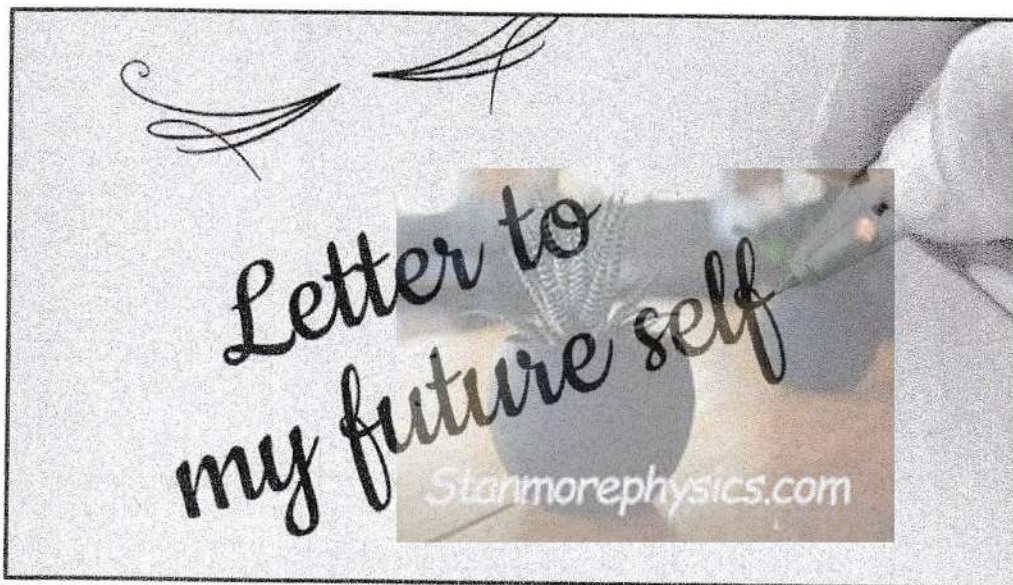
