1.1.4. Identify FOUR diverse range of topics and genre that are covered in the Songhai manuscripts (4 x 1) (4)

1.1.5. What does 'the diverse range of topics and genres in the Manuscripts' tell you about the level of education in Timbuktu? (2 x 2) (4)

1.2.1. Mention THREE learned persons, according to Leo Africanus account, that were maintained in the city of Timbuktu at the king's expense (3 x 1) (3)

1.2.2. Explain the concept *manuscript* in the context of Timbuktu as a strategic learning center. (1 x 2) (2)

1.2.3. Quote from the source to prove that Islamic scholarship flourished at Timbuktu (2 x 1) (2)

1.2.4. What does the statement 'he also employed trade inspectors at each of the empire's major trade centres' tell you about Askia the Great (1 x 2) (2)

1.2.5. Using information in the source and your own knowledge, explain why Timbuktu became strategic learning center in the Songhai Empire (2 x 2) (4)
