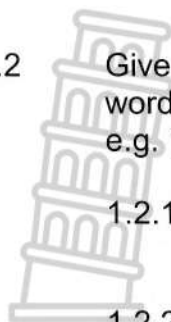

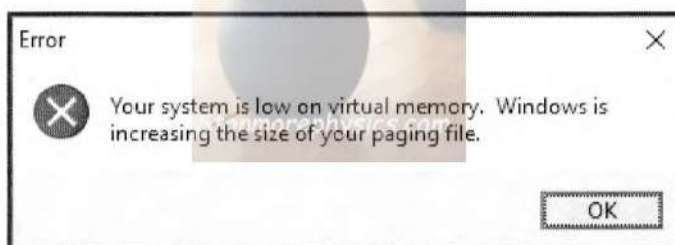
SCENARIO

CompuMart, a leading computer shop, is implementing improvement strategies to provide better services to both in-store and online customers.

2.1 The CompuMart team evaluates the latest memory and storage options of the computers at the store.

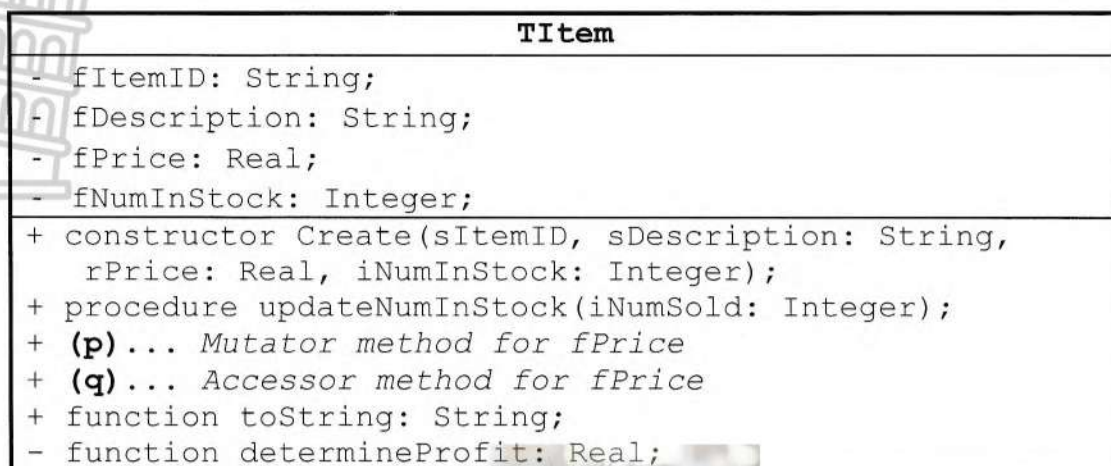

SCENARIO
