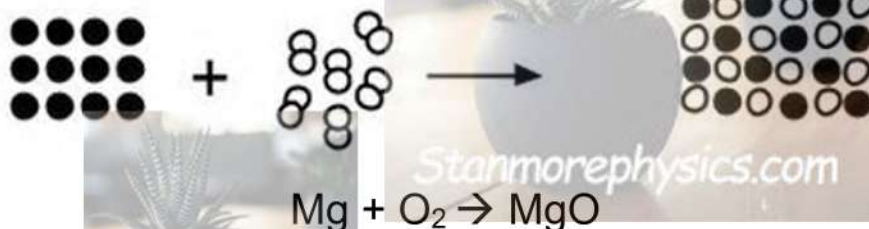

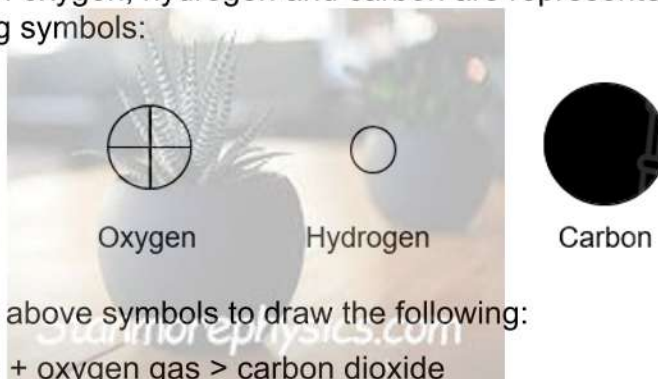
QUESTION 1

2. magnesium oxide ✓ (1)

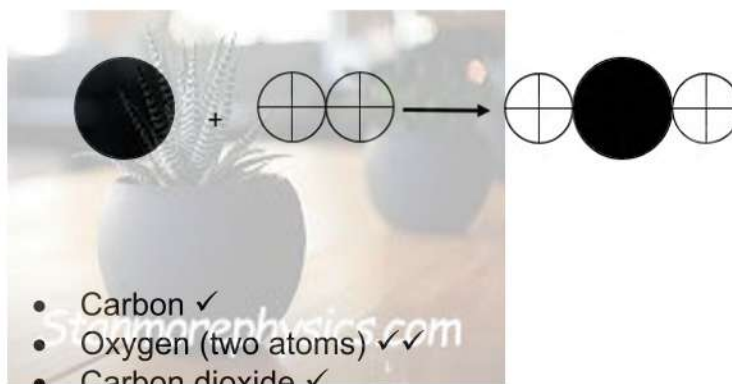
3. The same amount of atoms before ✓ and after the reaction. ✓ (2)

4. Before the reaction, all the magnesium atoms were bonded with each other, and all the oxygen atoms were bonded with each other. ✓ After the reaction the magnesium atoms have bonded with the oxygen atoms. ✓ (2)

5. solid phase ✓ Particles are close together (attracted to each other) ✓ (2)

6. Magnesium ✓ + Oxygen ✓ (gas) → magnesium oxide ✓ (3)
